










Some of the discoveries archeologists have made are:

Jericho had fortified walls/gate (Jos. 2:5, 7, 15).







City attacked in spring (Jos. 2:6; 3:15; 5:10).











- A layer of ash 3 feet thick with burned timbers and debris.


