 <u>"If your brother sins against you, go</u> and tell him his fault, bet yeen you
 and him alone the lister to you
 you ha God's will

A conditional statement

 "If your brother sins against you, <u>go</u> <u>and tell him his fault</u>, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have rained your brother. (Mt. 18:15 ES

> Show <u>him</u> his fault - Lev. 19:17

 "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, <u>between you</u> <u>and him alone</u>. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. (Mt. 18:15 ESV)

Brother A + Brother B

A conditional other sins against you, go statement his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. (Mt. 18:15 ESV)

> Reprove, Repent, Rejoice – Lk. 17:3-4; Mt. 18:21-22

 But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the endence of two or three witne es. (Mt. 18:16 ESV) A conditional statement

 But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evence of two or three witne (Mt. 18:16 ESV) Not "you and him alone"

• But if Confirm or Resolve take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses. (Mt. 18:16 ESV) Deu. 19:15; 2 Cor. 13:1; Jn. 8:17

 If he refuses to listen to them, <u>tell it</u> to the church. (Mat 18:17 ESV)

Sin becomes generally known

 —Private Mt. 18:21; Lk. 17:3-4

Making The Application

What about sins that aren't private?

-Restore - Gal. 6:1-2; Jas. 5:19-20

- -Not between "you and him alone"
 - Known– 1 Cor. 1:11; 5:1; Gal. 2:11-14
 - Danger of influence 1 Cor. 5:6-7
 - No "private" resolution

Making The Application

The goal is to gain the brother back!

What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them has gone astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine on the mountains and go in search of the one that went astray? And if he finds it, truly, I say to you, he rejoices over it more than over the ninety-nine that never went astray. So it is not the will of my Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish. (Mt. 18:12-14 ESV)
