Heb. 11:24-25; 2 Pet. 2:19



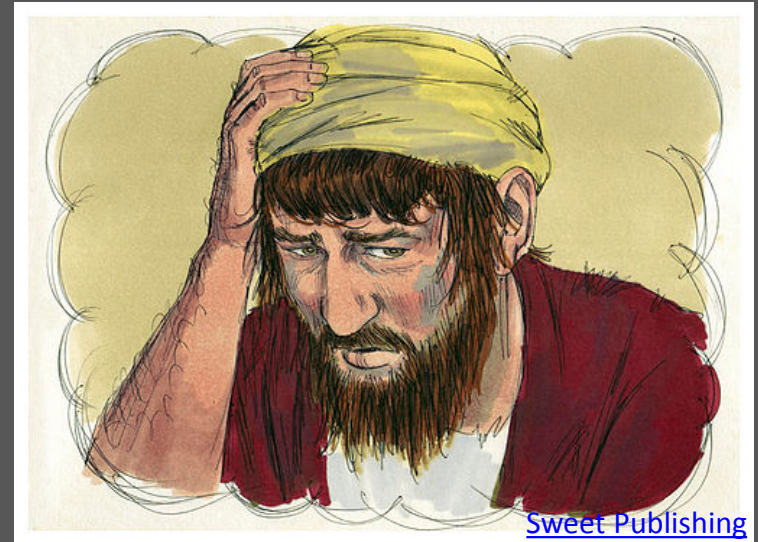
Away In A Far Country

- Repentance

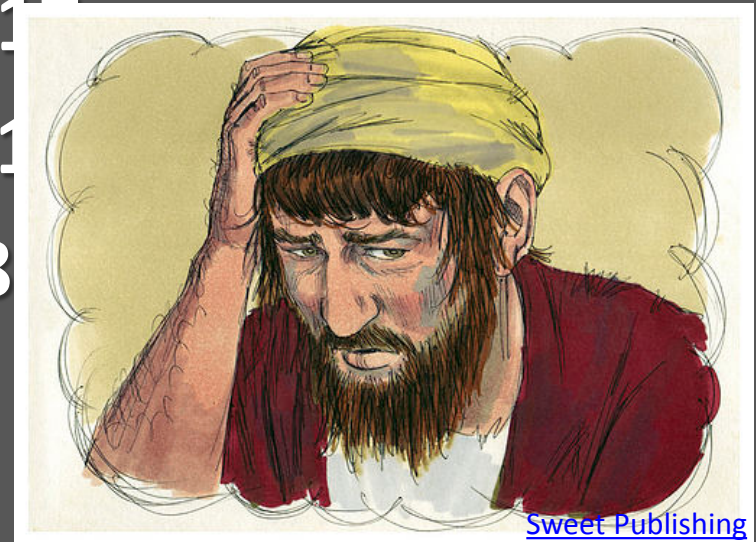
- All need it – Ac. 17:30; Rom. 3:23

- Godly sorrow – 2 Cor. 7:10

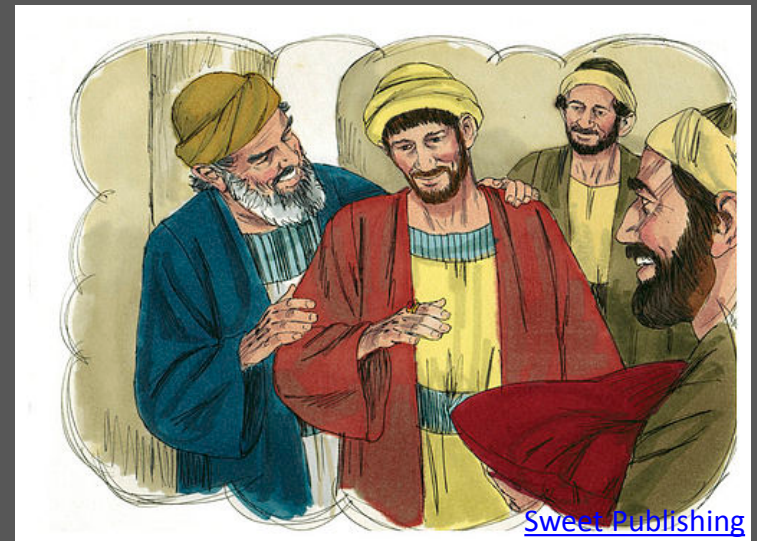
- Changed life – Mt. 21:28

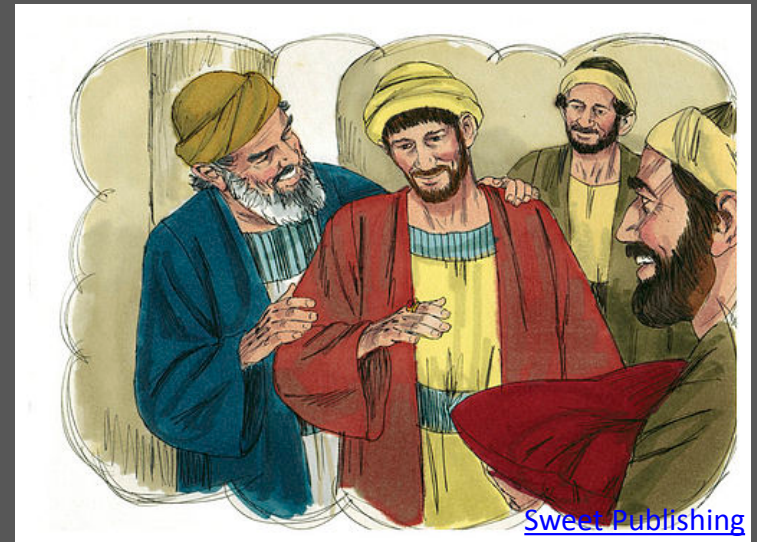
Returning & Rejoicing
